

## **Cape Meares Road Relocation**

# **Construction Activities & Upcoming Work**

The project achieved a major milestone this week in the completion of MSE Wall No. 2. In addition, construction began on MSE Wall No. 3 and is expected to continue for the next 4 to 6 weeks. A geotechnical engineer was onsite this week to oversee the beginning phases for MSE Wall No. 3. Truck traffic between the south project entrance and the adjacent Lighthouse Quarry will remain active but at varying levels in the coming weeks.

### **ROAD CLOSURES**

Current road closure points will remain in effect on Bayocean Road near the Cape Meares Lighthouse, and approximately 0.5 miles south of the Lighthouse. Construction will have minimal impact on public traffic as it is closed to through traffic. Please be advised that project limits are outside the gate on Cape Meares Loop coming south from Bayocean Road. See map on the following page for areas not accessible to the public.
