

## **Cape Meares Road Relocation**

# **Construction Activities & Upcoming Work**

Work continued throughout the week on MSE Wall No. 3. This week saw the completion of courses 12 through 15. In total, this wall will comprise 19 courses for a finished height of 28.5 feet. In addition, signs were added to Cape Meares Loop leading to the lighthouse to warn motorists of the road degradation from construction traffic at the south entrance to the site. Truck traffic between the south project entrance and the adjacent Lighthouse Quarry will remain active with reduced levels in the coming weeks.

#### **ROAD CLOSURES**

Current road closure points will remain in effect on Bayocean Road near the Cape Meares Lighthouse, and approximately 0.5 miles south of the Lighthouse. Construction will have minimal impact on public traffic as it is closed to through traffic. Please be advised that project limits are outside the gate on Cape Meares Loop coming south from Bayocean Road. See map on the following page for areas not accessible to the public.

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
